## Pollet campaign in the news

Hanford watchdog Gerry Pollet has been in the news the last couple of days as he finds himself engaged in quite a tussle for an open seat in the state House of Representatives.

Pollet is facing off against fellow Democrat Scott White and Republican Keith Ljunghammar, who appears likely to be knocked out of the race in next month's primary. White has most of the endorsements and more money than Pollet. But the scrappy Pollet might just have more street cred.

One thing I didn't know before reading the Times story is that White has been endorsed by both the Sierra Club and Washington Conservation Voters, which is noteworthy given Pollet's lengthy record as an environmental activist.
